Graham Moseley's funeral will be on 13th March at 12:45pm at St Stephen's Church followed by committal at the Crematorium.

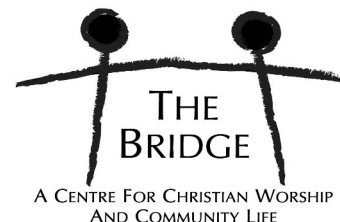
