COLLECTION FOR THE HOLY LAND

At last Monday's talk about the Holy Land a collection was taken to support the work of the **Bethlehem Arab Rehabilitation Centre**, a rehab centre and hospital visited during the recent Pilgrimage. A total of £150 was collected which has been sent to the centre.

This centre, in the Palestinian town of Bethlehem, is cut off from health services in Israel by the security wall erected in recent years and provides services on a shoe-string budget with some of the professional medical staff donating their time for 6 or 12 month periods.
