Potential Prayer activity:

I Samuel 7:12

New Living Translation (NLT)

¹² Samuel then took a **large stone** and placed it between the towns of Mizpah and Jeshanah.^[a] He named it **Ebenezer** (which means “the stone of help”), for he said, “**Up to this point the LORD has helped us!**”

The Message translation

Samuel took a **single rock** and set it upright between Mizpah and Shen. He named it “**Ebenezer**” (Rock of Help), saying, “**This marks the place where GOD helped us.**”
